DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Of all of the Easters past, what are some of your greatest memories?
- The cross is the significant icon of the Christian faith. Why
 do you think it is easier to worship a God who has to go
 to the cross? (Fact: the Jews and even Jesus' disciples
 wanted a Messiah who would conquer the Roman
 Empire and the world, so that the Jews could rule over all
 other nations.)
- 3. Verse 29 reveals something about the crowd there. What do you think this reveals about them and how does it apply to you and the world today?
- 4. Why do you think that Jesus said his soul was troubled? (This is not just about his death on the cross, so what else could Jesus mean?) Now read 2 Corinthians 5:21. Does this help you see Jesus' agony before going to the cross?
- 5. Did you love playing with magnets as a kid? What was the draw that caused you to love them? How do you see the cross in this same way? Jesus said he would draw all men to himself, but where was he when the draw would start? How does the cross draw all men/women to Jesus?
