DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 6. Growing up isn't optional. What do you think people are formed by the most in their lives? Why? How do these things draw us closer or further from Christ being formed in us?
- 7. Growing up isn't impossible. Honest self-evaluation time: Are you the closest to Jesus in this very moment than you have ever been? If the answer is no, then why? What has come in the way of your being formed into Christ's image? Pray for the Lord to remove these barriers and to form you in his image.
