DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. As you reflect on this chapter and miracle of Jesus, what parts stand out to you the most?
2. We see the two sides of Jesus: his deity (he is the resurrection and the life; he is God) and his humanity (he was troubled and he wept). Right now, which one of these speaks to you the most?
3. Robin brought up the real truth that we are all going to die. With that reality in mind, how should you live your life this week?
4. It's not that people doubt the existence of God, but they doubt the goodness of God. How does this story help us see God's goodness in new ways?
5. Jesus does one of the most powerful miracles in the Bible: he raises a man who was four days dead! How does this comfort you — that Jesus offers us more than well-wishes and sympathy?
6. Have you ever shared in Mary and Martha's question, "God, where are you?" How is the hope of resurrection more compelling than a simple answer to our questions?
7. In what areas of faith and practices are you feeling convicted by the Holy Spirit to act as a result of this study?
